NEW Returnable Adjustment Allowance (RAA)

The RAA will provide assistance to families with children 0 to 17 yrs of age waiting until they receive their CCTB, NCBS and OCB allowances. The amount will be: \$100 per child per month for a four month period for a total of \$400 per child. The RAA will be paid to clients with children in the first four months after arrival (\$100 per month) and will be recouped starting in the fifth or sixth month and dependent on receipt of national and provincial child benefits.
